The Foodbank aims to make sure that no one in our local community has to go hungry, but they need our help to make this happen. Over 90% of the food distributed by foodbanks is donated by the public – that's why your food donations are absolutely vital to give them the ability to give everyone referred to them a balanced and nutritious three day supply of food.

Currently, these are the items on the shopping list that are urgently needed:

TINNED VEG (NO SWEETCORN OR KIDNEY PLEASE)
DESSERTS (NO JELLY)
HAND SOAP
WASHING POWDER/LIQUID
TOILETRIES E.G DEODORANT, SHOWER GEL, TOOTHPASTE, TOILET ROLLS

They have plenty of cereal, tinned soup and meat, and pasta sauce so please do not donate these items, or anything without a long shelf life, at this time. You can find further details on their website:
