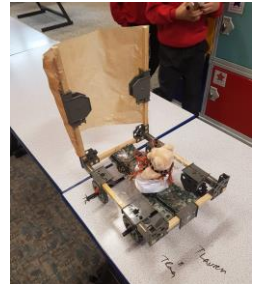

Please check the health advice, which has been sent home in children's book bags, to guide you as to when your child should and should not be in school. Thank you.










